Following the decision on 16th March, 2010 to review the existing IPPC licence (Reg. No. P0088-02) granted to Anglo American Lisheen Mining Limited, located at Killoran, Barnalisheen, Ballyerk, Cooleeny and Derryfadda, Moynes, Thurles, County Tipperary, National Grid Reference E2212 N1664. On 16th March, 2010 the Agency proposed to grant a revised licence, subject to conditions (Reg. No. P0088-03), for class 1.3.0 - The extraction and processing (including size reduction, grading and heating) of minerals within the meaning of the Minerals Development Acts 1940 to 1999, where an activity involves -

- (a) a metalliferous operation, or
- (b) any other operation where either the level of extracted or processed minerals is greater than 200,000 tonnes per annum or the total operational yield is greater than 1,000,000 tonnes, and storage of related mineral waste.

Resource Property Investment Fund Plc is applying for permission for the demolition of all existing structures, site clearance and the removal of an establishment to which the Seveso II Directive applies, on the site currently occupied by the Topaz Energy terminal, located within the ward of Knockree B, Centre Park Road, Cork City. The site is bounded by Centre Park Road to the north. Permission is sought for redevelopment of the site and all site development works to incorporate the construction of a mixed-use retail/commercial development ranging from 2 to 9 storeys over basement, including mezzanine at ground floor. It is proposed to erect two buildings on the cleared site, namely Block A and Block B. Block A, a focal building, is located at the north west boundary of the site and will consist of 1 no. café (251sqm g.f.a), 2 no retail general stores (430sqm g.f.a), 2 no. retail comparison stores (638sqm g.f.a), 1 no. retail warehouse unit (812sqm g.f.a), 5,311sqm of offices from 2nd floor to 8th floor and ancillary space, podium landscaped area at 2nd floor, terrace area at 8th floor, green roofs and solar panels at roof level. Block B fronts onto Centre Park Road and consists of 2 no. cafés (681sqm g.f.a), 2 no. convenience stores (197sqm g.f.a), 5 no. retail general units (697sqm g.f.a), a retail anchor store with a g.f.a of 8101sqm (2299.2sqm net convenience & 1840sqm net comparison), 15,322sqm of offices from 1st floor to 7th floor, a three storey medical centre (2,873sqm g.f.a) which connects Block A and Block B, a gym (572sqm g.f.a), anchor retail service area, podium landscaped areas at second floor, a winter garden at second floor of medical centre, travelators from basement to ground floor level and escalators from ground to first floor, storage areas, plant rooms, ancillary space, waste areas, switch rooms, substations, green roofs and solar panels at roof level. The development also proposes a basement level car park consisting of 339 parking spaces, 334 bicycle parking spaces, ancillary service areas and services area for drainage, all at basement level. The development also includes a temporary access road with access control gate from Monahan's Road to the south with new junction layout at Monahan's Road, new footpath from Monahan's Road to development, new public street, bridge over existing culvert and relocation of 2nd existing culvert, surface water swale, a new access from Centre Park Road for service vehicles only exiting through a temporary egress lane onto Centre Park Road, landscaping and all associated site development works. It is also proposed to raise ground levels to 6.0m
