A.4 Storm Water Overflows

Delete the reference to Athboy Pumping Station.

Following discussion, the Directors approved the recommended decision to grant a licence, as modified, to Meath County Council for the waste water discharge relating to the Athboy, Rathcairn & Environs agglomeration, Register of Licence No D0124-01, subject to the conditions as set out in the licence document.
