

**Extract from the Minutes of the 720<sup>th</sup> Licensing Meeting of the Environmental Protection Agency,  
held on 22 January 2012  
at EPA Headquarters, Johnstown Castle Estate, Co. Wexford.**

1. The 720<sup>th</sup> Licensing Meeting of the Agency was held on 22 January 2013, in EPA Headquarters, Johnstown Castle Estate, Co. Wexford.

The Directors considered the following documentation: Proposed Determination issued on 20 March 2012; 1 First-Party objection and the report and recommendations of the Technical Committee, Office of Climate, Licensing and Resource Use.

A copy of the licence application was available electronically.

Marie O'Connor gave a verbal presentation.

**Technical Committee Report**

The Directors noted the Technical Committee Report and approved the recommendations of the Technical Committee with the following amendments:

**A.1 Schedule B.2 – Emissions to Water, Emissions Point Reference No.: SW3**

Delete emissions point reference SW3 table from Schedule B.2 Emission to Water and insert two new conditions as follows;

**6.17.1** Insert Condition 6.17.1 as follows: *'The licensee shall, within six months of the date of grant of licence, establish trigger levels for discharges at SW3 for the parameters specified in Schedule C.2.2 Monitoring of emissions to water to the satisfaction of the Agency. The licensee shall have regard to the EPA 'Guidance on the setting of trigger levels at EPA IPPC and Waste licensed facilities' and the trigger levels shall be set so as to ensure compliance with the requirements of the EC Environmental Objectives (Surface waters) Regulations 2009 (as amended) in the receiving water.'*

**6.17.2** Insert Condition 6.17.2 as follows: *'The licensee shall, within twelve months of the date of grant of licence, carry out an investigation for the identification of all discharges into the Bunlicky pond and an assessment of the risks to compliance with a) the EC Environmental Objectives (Surface waters) Regulations 2009 (as amended) and b) the trigger levels established in accordance with Condition 6.17.1, at the discharge SW3. The licensee shall prepare and maintain a risk management plan. The outcomes of the risk assessment, information on measures implemented and the risk management plan shall be reported to the Agency as part of the AER for 2014.'*

Following discussion, the Directors decided to grant a licence, as modified, to Irish Cement Limited, for their facility at, Castlemungret, County Limerick, Register of Licence No P0029-03, subject to the conditions as set out in the licence.
