PLANNING APPLICATIONS

KERRY COUNTY COUNCIL — WE, ESB TELECOM LTD are applying for Permission at the Tralee 110kV substation, Dromthacker, Tralee, Co. Kerry, for the continuance of use of the existing 36 metre high free standing lattice communications structure, carrying antennae and communications dishes together with associated ground-mounted equipment within a 2.4 metre palisade fenced compound, and for permission to attach additional dishes and antennae for future co-location. The planning application may be inspected or purchased at a fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy at the offices of the Planning Authority at County Buildings, Rathass, Tralee, during its public opening hours: Monday to Friday 9.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. A submission or observation in relation to the application may be made in writing to the Planning Authority on payment of the prescribed fee of EUR20 within the period of 5 weeks beginning on the date of receipt by the Authority of the application, and such submissions or observations will be considered by the Planning Authority in making a decision on the application. The Planning Authority may grant permission subject to or without conditions, and may refuse to grant permission.

DUN LAOGHAIRE RATHDOWN COUNTY COUNCIL — We Amgen Technology (Ireland) intend to apply for permission for development located on our site on Pottery Road, Dun Laoghaire, Co. Dub. The development will consist of: The extension of the existing previously permitted Warehouse Yard area by 600m². (Planning Reference Number D12A/0381 dated 19th December 2012). The construction of a retaining wall (maximum 3 meters high) and the lowering of the existing landscaped berms by 1.5 meters approximately, all to the rear of the existing Amgen site, together with revised underground services and landscaping. The length of the affected berm is 100 meters to the north face of the existing warehouse yard. This application consists of a variation to a previously permitted development of an activity for which a licence under Part IV of the Environmental

The Agency granted a revised IPPC licence, subject to conditions, on 5th June 2013, to Shell E&P Ireland Limited, Corrib House, 52 Lower Leeson Street, Dublin 2, located at Bellanaboy Bridge Gas Terminal, Bellanaboy Bridge, Bellagelilly South, County Mayo, National Grid Reference E6428 N3125, Register No. P0738-02, for Class 9.3.1: the operation of a gas refinery and Class 2.1.0: the operation of combustion installations with a rated thermal input equal to or greater than 50MW. A person shall not question the validity of the decision of the Agency other than by way of an application for judicial review and any such application or any other legal proceedings must, in accordance with Section 87(10) of the EPA Acts 1992 to 2013, be instituted within the period of eight weeks beginning on the date of the giving of the decision. **The High Court may extend the period for bringing proceedings where it is satisfied that there is good and sufficient reason for doing so. In this respect it is pointed out that this notice is being published late and may be sufficient reason to extend time by a further 18 days.** The decision, including the reasons and considerations on which the decision is based, the revised licence, conditions and any subsequent updates may be inspected at EPA Headquarters, P.O.
