Decision & Reasons for the Decision

The Board agreed amend the second paragraph of the Decision & Reasons for the Decision as follows; *'In reaching this decision, the Environmental Protection Agency has considered the documentation relating to application, Register Number: P0950-01. This includes supporting documentation received from the applicant, all submissions received from other parties, the report of the Licensing Inspector, all objections and submissions on objections, and report of the Technical Committee addressing the objections to the Proposed Determination and the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) report.*

It is considered that the Environmental Impact Assessment Report (as included in the Inspectors Report dated 27/02/2013) contains a fair and reasonable assessment of the likely significant effects of the licensed activity on the environment. The assessment as reported is adopted as the assessment of the Agency. Having regard to this assessment, it is considered that the proposed activity, if managed, operated and controlled in accordance with the licence will not result in the contravention of any relevant environmental quality standards or cause environmental pollution.'

Following discussion, the Directors decided to grant a licence, to Irish Biofuels Production Limited, for their facility at, Bollarney Murragh, Wicklow, County Wicklow, Register of Licence No P0950-01, subject to the conditions as set out in the licence.
