**Notice under

Regulations 2013**

The Agency granted an Industrial Emissions licence, subject to conditions, on 30th April 2014, to Mayo Renewable Power Limited, Riverside One, Sir John Rogersons Quay, Dublin 2, Reg. No. P0958-01, for Class 1.1: combustion of fuels in installations with a total rated thermal input of 50 MW or more, at Killalla Business Park, Tawnaghmore Upper & Tawnaghmore Lower, Killala, Co Mayo, National Grid Reference E1205N3278. A person shall not question the validity of the decision of the Agency other than by way of an application for judicial review and any such application or any other legal proceedings must, in accordance with Section 87(10) of the EPA Act 1992 as amended, be instituted within the period of eight weeks beginning on the date of the giving of the decision. The decision, including the reasons and considerations on which the decision is based, the licence, conditions, and any subsequent updates may be inspected at EPA Headquarters, P.O.
