Unit 1: Local and Global Issues

Teaching Point

Local and global environmental issues threaten our local area. These threats result from our own behaviour and activities and also originate in other areas of the globe.

Outcomes: Having completed this unit students should be able to:

- ✎ Identify the local and global environmental issues, which concern and threaten their local environment.
- ✎ Understand the sources of these threats.
- ✎ Evaluate the possible solutions to these threats.
- ✎ Establish where decisions, which influence these threats, are taken.

Aonad 1: Ceisteanna Domhanda agus Áitiúla

Pointe Teagaisc

Torthaí: Tar éis an aonaid seo a chríochnú ba chóir go mbeadh daltaí ábalta:

- ✎ ceisteanna timpeallachta domhanda agus áitiúla a bhaineann leis an timpeallacht áitiúil, agus atá ina mbagairt di, a aithint.
- ✎ foinsí na mbagairtí sin a thuiscint.
- ✎ mesúnú a dhéanamh ar na réitigh atá ar na bagairtí sin.
- ✎ a shocrú cén uair ba chóir cinntí, a mbíonn tionchar acu ar na bagairtí sin, a ghlacadh.

Activities

Brainstorming

- 1 Teacher brainstorms the class to identify what the students consider to be the main environmental threats to their lives and activities. Discuss each hazard or threat identified. Classify the source of the problem as local, national or global.

Example: Brainstorm produces list including

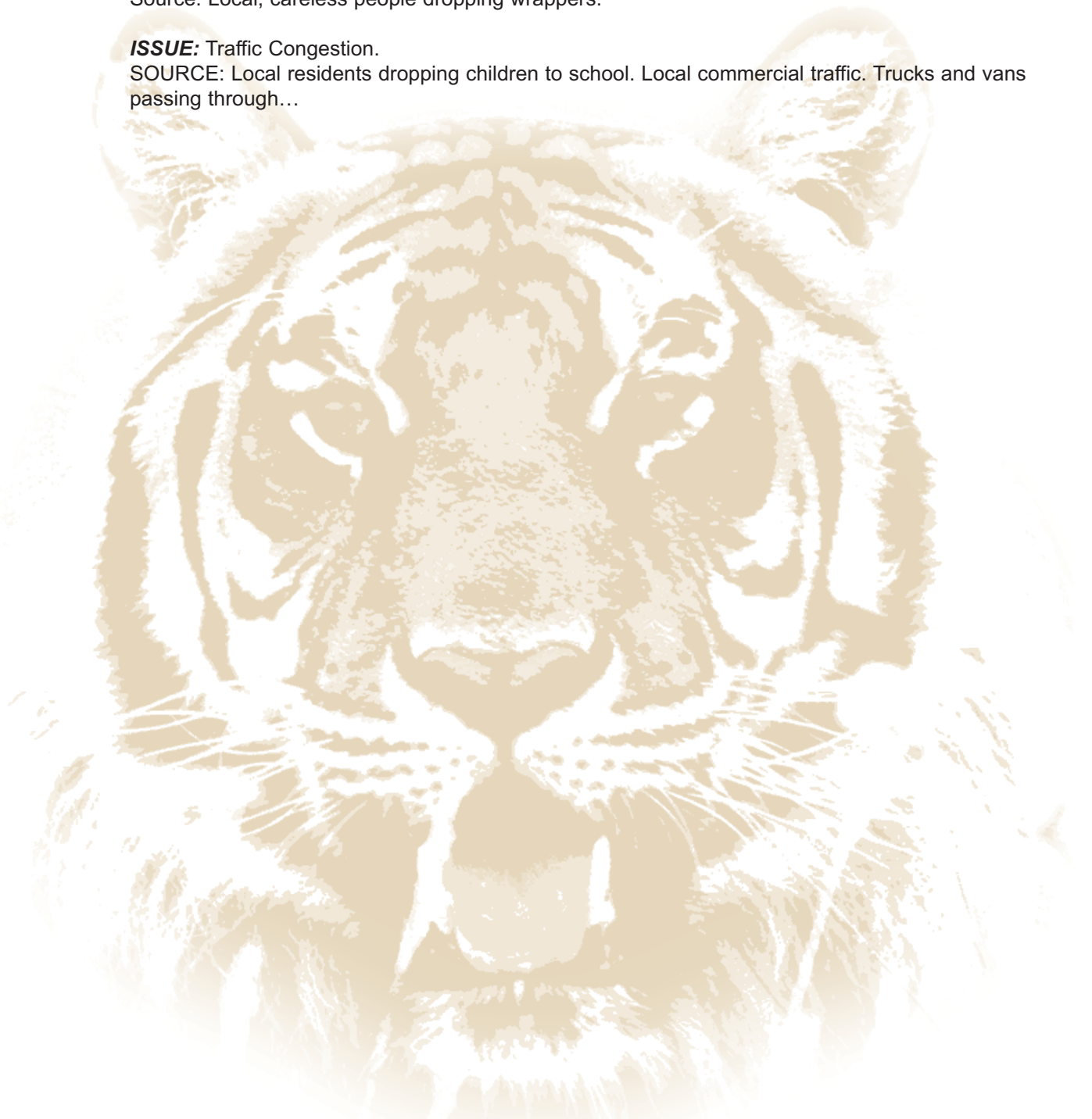
LITTER, TRAFFIC, AIR POLLUTION, SMOKE, WATER POLLUTION, TOO MANY HOUSES WITH NO PLAY AREAS, SLURRY FROM FARMS, UGLY BUILDINGS, LANDFILLS.

ISSUE: Litter.

Source: Local, careless people dropping wrappers.

ISSUE: Traffic Congestion.

SOURCE: Local residents dropping children to school. Local commercial traffic. Trucks and vans passing through...



Group work

2 Divide the class into small working groups. Each group will take one of the hazards identified and look in detail at the nature of the hazard under the following headings.

- ✎ Variety of sources.
- ✎ Impact on the community.
- ✎ Possible solutions or alternatives.
- ✎ Public policy. Who decides, who has the power to effect change.
- ✎ Class suggestions and report.

Consider the issue of sustainable development in relation to the key issues identified. Consider how economic, social and environmental considerations can be managed to ensure a sustainable future for all those affected.

Group Work: Small group discussion. One issue per group.

5 minutes discussion time.

Example: Traffic Congestion.

Variety of sources: Cars, trucks, vans, school runs, on street parking, loading and unloading.

Impact on the community: Noise, smoke and fumes, smell, traffic jams, danger to children and old people crossing roads.

Possible solutions or alternatives: *Easy:* One way system, traffic lights, pedestrian lights, traffic wardens, more Garda activities, speed traps. *More complicated:* Off street parking, park and ride, public transport, cycle paths, parking fees. A by pass.

Public policy: Is there a Local Council traffic management strategy? What is planned for your area? Who decides? - your local representatives with the transport department of the local council?

Class suggestions and report: *What would you do to ensure a sustainable future for your community?*

A one- year plan: Disk parking, speed limits, pedestrian crossings. A free bus service.....

A five-year plan: A by pass, one-way system, cycle paths.....

Write a short individual report on your group's discussions and conclusions.

Now Duncan asks the question why are these the major threats to our environment in Ireland? He seems to suggest that the whole situation is caused by one thing. . . complacency???

We are told that there are 3.5 million of us responsible!!!

But why? What do you or I do?

Duncan lists a number of statistics which are used to show our complacency;

Solutions

Duncan now goes on to suggest the main solution to all our environmental problems. There is no magic wand. He introduces us to the idea of sustainability.

Sustainability: This is a way of life which over time will not threaten or damage the environment for future generations. Our actions today should not cause problems for those who will inherit the locality, country or planet from us. Sustainable developments, therefore, are actions which will not damage or threaten the environment but preserve and enhance it.

Now the video sequences looks at four everyday activities, which we take for granted, and identifies how each is unsustainable. Take another look!
