- What is a Joint Programming Initiative?
 - Bottom-up process whereby Member States agree, in partnership and voluntarily, on common visions and Strategic Research Agendas (SRAs) to address major societal challenges
 - Pool national research efforts in order to make better use of Europe's public R&D resources

■ STRATEGIC RESEARCH AGENDA:

- SRA published February 2014
- High level document presenting cultural heritage as an integrated research area
- 16 countries each consulted with experts across all areas of cultural heritage – tangible, intangible and digital
- Aim was for the process and information to be transparent

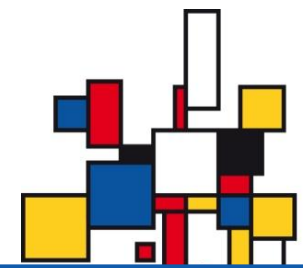

■ JOINT CALLS

- Pilot Call – January 2013
- Heritage+ Call – March 2014

- Virtual common pot model
- 89 proposals received
- 10 projects funded
- €3.3m total funding allocated

- 1 Irish project: SHUC – A sustainable future for the historic urban core (UCD)

- Workshop October 29th, Dublin, will present the preliminary results for each project

■ JOINT CALLS

- Pilot Call – January 2013
- Heritage+ Call – March 2014

- ERA-Net+ Call
- 2 stage process
- 350 pre-proposals received
- c.50 projects selected for second stage evaluation
- Final results announced February 2015
- Successful projects to start April 2015
- €9m total funding available
