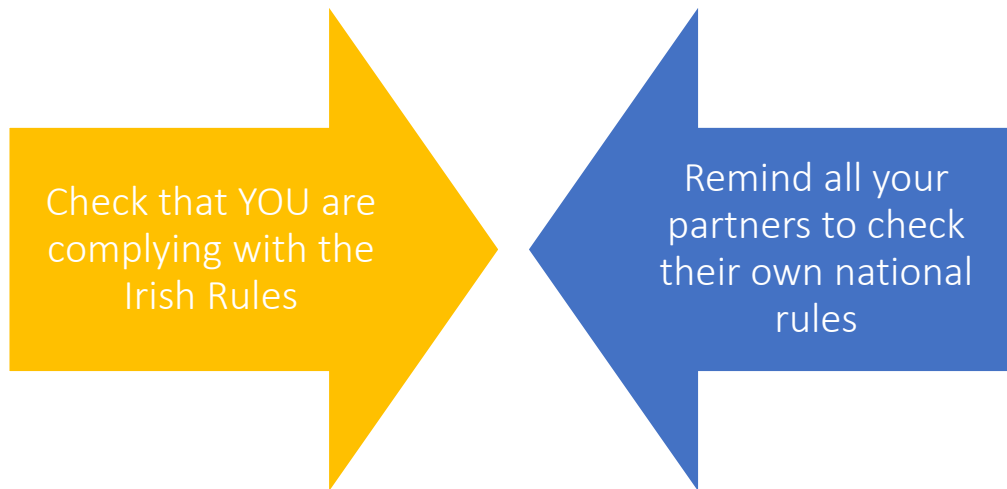
- **Sub-topic-2.a.** Developing systems for universal and equitable access to safe and affordable drinking water for all

Irish - How much?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Irish researchers can request up to: • €150,000 for partners • €300,000 for coordinator • €300,000 as the Total budget of ALL Irish partners within the one proposal

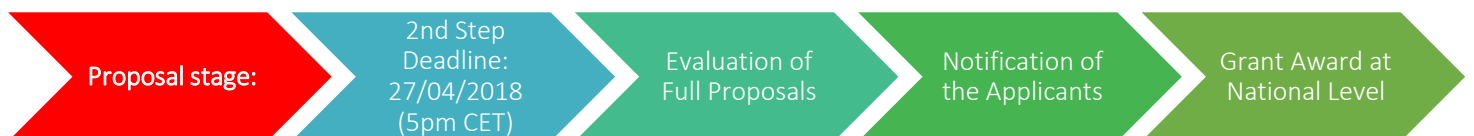

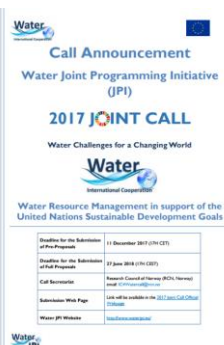
