


THE CIRCULAR ECONOMY IN IRELAND

The circular economy aims to reduce waste at all stages of the economic cycle and ensure materials are used as efficiently as possible. Waste prevention, a central concept of the circular economy, challenges us to review our existing design, production, distribution and consumption of products. This will move us from the current linear model of Take > Make > Use > Dispose to a more efficient and low-carbon economy.

The Environmental Protection Agency leads Ireland's **National Waste Prevention Programme** with the Department of Communications, Climate Action and Environment. We provide tools and information to businesses, households and the public sector to influence behavioural change and support sustainable choices.

For businesses, the circular economy reduces costs, improves the raw material supply chain and offers opportunities such as new business models and markets. For individuals, the circular economy offers a sustainable lifestyle with reduced environmental impact and lower household bills.


