Galway, the assessment of the appeal; a report by An Bord Pleanála inspector and the recommendation from the Office of Environmental Sustainability to refuse the appeal. Recommended Decision

The Directors also agreed that the Office of Environmental Sustainability;

- will advise all Local Authorities that an Appropriate Assessment screening should be completed by the Local Authority as part of the assessment of an Air Pollution Act 1987 licence application;
- will assess future appeals in-house, and;
- will explain to the Local Authorities and Public that the scope of the appeal is limited to air pollution matters and doesn't extend to planning issues.
