

# **Site Visit Report**

Under the European Union (Drinking Water) Regulations 2014 as amended, the Environmental Protection Agency is the supervisory authority in relation to Irish Water and its role in the provision of public water supplies. This Audit was carried out to assess the performance of Irish Water in providing clean and wholesome water to the visited public supply.

(1) Disinfection consists of chlorination. The audit found that the disinfection system was operating satisfactorily during the inspection.



#### Introduction

The Bandon Regional Public Water Supply (PWS) produces approximately 4,234 m3/d of water serving a population of 9,170 (EDEN figures). The supply is sourced from the Bandon River. This audit focused on the disinfection system at the Bandon Regional WTP where Chlorination is the primary disinfection. The site has been assessed under Irish Water's Disinfection Programme and reported to the EPA as having been fully commissioned and available on telemetry on 20/12/2020.
