PUBLIC NOTICE 17 August 2020

As outlined in our last Status Update published on 31 July 2020, a stockpile of approximately 3,500 tonnes of contaminated material, which was excavated as part of the Limerick Gasworks Remediation Project, is now ready for removal by ship for disposal abroad.

The material is being transferred from the Limerick Gasworks site by truck. It is expected that the transfer will take 2 days, and will be conducted on Tuesday 18th and Wednesday 19th August.

This will be the last major task of the project. The remaining works will involve redistribution of processed material over the site to leave a clean and level surface.

Gas Networks Ireland have indicated that this work will be completed before the end of August. At that stage, the site will be fully remediated, and will enter the aftercare period.

The EPA will be onsite to supervise the transfer and to ensure that offsite impacts are minimised. We will also be conducting continuous monitoring of a range of volatile substances likely to be present in any emissions that are generated by the transfer works.
