
Summary: The purpose of the visit was to

- i) Ascertain whether peat extraction activities were been carried out by one or more parties at the above address in Co Westmeath.
- ii) The site visit commenced on lands where excavation, turning and stockpiling of sodpeat following extraction activity was noted.

Findings of site visit of 27/4/2022: The following was noted during the visit:

- No peat excavation machinery was noted on the bog (Appendix 1) at the Ballymaglavy, Co. Westmeath.
- Sod peat had been placed on a significant area of the peatland since the previous visit in February 2022 where sods of peat had been excavated and left on the bog for drying (see Appendix 2 photographs).
- A significant amount of the sod peat rows noted in a previous visit had now been removed off the peatland.
- The recently excavated sod peat was spread over an area on 39 separate sections of 12 meters wide for each section.






Photo 1: Sod peat which was recently excavated and left on the peatland to dry.
