



SITE VISIT REPORT

Purpose of Site Visit: Westmeath Peat Extraction

Site Address: Blyry Lower Bog, Tullycross and Blyry, Athlone, County Westmeath

Date of Visit: 12/05/2022

Times of Visit: 0945 to 1015

Visit Criteria: Peat extraction investigation

EPA Attendees: Mick Henry and John Gibbons

Summary: The purpose of the visit was to

- i) Ascertain whether peat extraction activities were been carried out on lands at the above address in County Westmeath.
- ii) To determine what activity and the location of the activities been undertaken was carried out at during recent months. The site visit commenced on lands that were the subject of correspondence received by the Agency in April 2022 where extraction of peat on a commercial scale was alleged.

Findings of site visit of 12/05/2022: The following was noted during the visit:

- A section of the peatland was being harrowed during the visit.
- A tracked dumper was being filled with milled peat from a large stockpile out on the peatland and was hauling the milled peat to the loading area.
- A number of machines for harvesting peat was noted at the loading area.
- We spoke to the driver of a tractor which was harrowing the peatland and he refused to give us his name. The man asked Mr. Gibbons to speak to [REDACTED] on his phone. [REDACTED] asked Mr. Gibbons to meet with him tomorrow and a meeting was arranged.
- A number of fuel drums and containers were noted at the loading area.
