Purpose of Site Visit: Peat Extraction in Co. Tipperary
Site Address: Monaincha, Roscrea, Co Tipperary

Summary: The purpose of the visit was to

- i) Ascertain whether peat extraction activities were being carried out on lands at Monaincha, Roscrea, Co Tipperary. This peat land is located immediately adjacent to Monaincha Bog NHA.

Findings of site visit of 14/02/2025: The following was noted during the visit:

- The site was inspected by walking parts of the bog as well as taking some drone photography.
- There was no peat extraction activity ongoing at the time of the inspection.
- There were two stockpiles of previously excavated peat (Photo 2) being stored at the western edge of the peatland.
