We are writing to object, to the Licence given to John Madden by Galway County Council, for his Tar Plant in Ardraham, County Galway. The Licence Number is: AP13/20 We are living locally and are very worried that there will be serious pollution from this Tar Plant. We believe it will cause health problems for people living in the area.

There is already a big dust and noise problem at the site and this will make that problem worse. We believe there will be problems with smells from the tar, dust in the air and a lot of loud noises, because of the operation of this plant.

We don't want this plant making tar, down the road from us, no more than anybody else would.
