

Application Form for Registration of Solid Fuel Producers under Regulation 6 of the Air Pollution Act 1987 (Solid Fuel) Regulations 2022 (Statutory Instrument No. 529 of 2022).

Background Information

The Air Pollution Act (Solid Fuels) Regulations 2022, S.I. No. 529 of 2022, (the Regulations) require solid fuel producers to:

- 1. Register with the Environmental Protection Agency annually before September 1 each year.
- 2. Provide the Environmental Protection Agency with information it may reasonably require for the purposes of fulfilling its statutory functions.
- 3. Provide a valid Certificate of Compliance from a third-party certification body to verify that the solid fuel you intend to place on the market complies with the requirements as set out in Regulation 5 and is issued by a certification body under Regulation 10. A copy of the Certificate of Compliance must be submitted to the EPA at FuelRegistration@epa.ie
- Submit a registration fee of €100.

Under the Regulations, it is prohibited to retail or distribute solid fuel, for the purposes of combustion for heating (space or water) in a fireplace in a domestic or a licensed premises, other than an approved solid fuel.

To be approved under the Regulations, a solid fuel must conform to the relevant requirements:

- Coal products and manufactured solid fuels must have a smoke emission rate of less than 10 grams per hour
- Manufactured part-biomass products must have a smoke emission rate of less than 5 grams per hour.
- Coal products and manufactured solid fuels, including manufactured part-biomass products, must have:
 - Until 31st August 2030 (subject to market assessment), a sulphur content less than 2% by weight on a dry, ash-free basis, and
- Fuel products which are 100% biomass products, including wood products and wood logs, (other than wood supplied in units of two cubic metres or more), must have:
 - Until 31st August 2025 (subject to market assessment), a moisture content of less than 25%



Instructions

The Application Form for Registration may be submitted electronically or as a hard copy as instructed. The Certificate of Compliance issued by a certification body under Regulation 10 must be included for the application to be processed.

The form should preferably be completed electronically and should be sent via e-mail to FuelRegistration@epa.ie with a copy of the Certificate of Compliance.

Alternatively, the completed Registration Form may be submitted as a hard copy, along with a copy of the Certificate of Compliance, to:
