Enclosed is a copy of 4 appeals under the Air Pollution Act 1987 in relation to the decision regarding the above.

So that consideration of the appeals may proceed, you are requested to forward **two hard copies and one electronic copy on CD-Rom** of the following documents to the Environmental Protection Agency ("the Agency") **within two weeks** of the date of this letter: -

1. The application made to the planning authority.
2. A copy of the public notice published in respect of the application.
3. Any drawings, maps, particulars, information, evidence or written study received or obtained from the applicant in accordance with the provisions of Article 8 of the Air Pollution Act, 1987, (Licensing of Industrial Plant) Regulations, 1988.
4. Details of any investigations carried out under the provisions of Article 8 of the said Regulations by the authority in connection with the application.
5. A certified copy of the relevant Manager's Order.
6. A copy of the Air Emissions Licence.
7. Copies of any technical or other reports relevant to the decision on the application.
8. Copies of any submissions or objections made to the planning authority in relation to the application.
9. Plans and particulars in relation to any relevant planning applications on the site.

Please note that the parties to the appeals are being notified that copies of the documents relevant to the application the subject of the appeal will be available for inspection at your offices after the expiration of a period of **fourteen days** from the date of this letter.

It is assumed that the local authority has notified observers of the decision made and of the right of appeal.

The local authority may make to the Agency, in writing, such observations on the appeals as it thinks fit. Where practicable observations should be submitted with the documents listed above but the furnishing of the documents need not be held up until observations are available. Any observations should be furnished **within one month** of the date of this letter if they are to be taken into account in the determination of the appeals.
