Dear Sirs,

Everyday one reads in the papers, online or on television some report or other about climate change, floods, fires raging out of control and what we should do to stem the tide. Mostly it is to "stop pollution getting into the atmosphere." yet Kerry County Council saw fit to allow very dangerous, toxic, poisonous chemicals be brought, transported, manufactured in the midst of houses, people, farmlands, animals, school (over 250 pupils) all within one mile of this proposed plant, which will have to be fully constructed if the go ahead is given. Before this happens please stop this pollution in our midst. They, Roadstone, have plenty pollution operations (20 we understand) around Ireland without adding another.

Malone Regan Environmental monitored the ambient PM10 at the far eastern side of the site near Woodland (one monitor) we don't know how accurate that would

be since most wind / rain is south / south westerly where we would be located. see Cork Airport data which is over 1 hour 10 minutes from site or Valentia which is 56 Km. from site as the snow flies.

"No odour nuisance will occur beyond the sand pit boundary at Clashkeen" as we are also in Clashkeen we can fully assume we will be shocked by the ongoing fumes.

E.P.D (3rd June, 2021) "5 Key Pollutants which impact Air Quality, health and environment" (1) sulphur dioxide and (2) Nitrogen Oxide. Both will be emitted plus others.

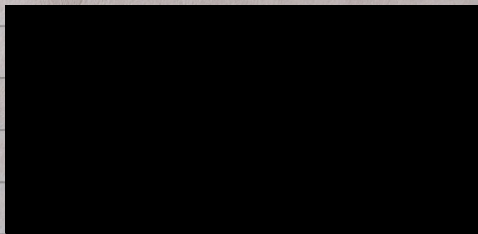
Carbon Monoxide poison has been modelled over 8 hours but this site proposes at least 13 possibly 15 hours and if customers require it could operate twenty four hours a day with no cut off time or time limit on licence.

Envirocon (Page 2) Shehera Bog is measured @ 5 Kg / ha / yr currently higher upper critical load value of 11.4 Kg / ha / yr ref. Henry & Shere study. This is over twice the reading so how much of the other data contained is under declared to meet planning / environment and tick box exercises. Poison is Poison and no amount of dressing up figures / charts to make it pass is acceptable.

We would ask you to be forthright and protect our environment by totally refusing this licence. We can't see ~~any~~ justification for it. Will they have to apply for planning permission to add asphalt plant buildings? So before anything is granted please refuse and protect us humans, animals and our beautiful countryside, and not let future generations say to right an environmental wrong.
