

**Application Screening for Compliance with Section 87(1B) of the EPA Act 1992 (IE/IPC) /
Section 42(1B) of the Waste Management Act 1996 (Waste)**

On submission of an application, the Agency will conduct an examination for specific documentation where the activity involves development of which a grant of planning permission is required. This examination is to ensure compliance with [Section 87\(1B\) of the EPA Act 1992, as amended \(IE/IPC\)](#) / [Section 42\(1B\) of the Waste Management Act 1996, as amended \(Waste\)](#).

The following documentation is required for planning granted or under consideration **relevant to the application**:

In addition, applicants are required to list all planning permissions that **relate to activities on the site** (including previous planning submitted to the Agency if application is a Licence review) in the stakeholder engagement section of the application form, and for each planning permission, include the following:

- a copy of the Final Grant of Permission; and
- where an EIS/EIAR was not required for the listed planning, include a letter from the planning authority confirming that an EIS/EIAR was not required.

All applicants should ensure the [‘Stakeholder Engagement’ section](#) of the application has been updated accordingly to include the above criteria.

Where applicants fail to provide above referenced information, the Agency shall refuse to consider your application, as it is obliged to do in accordance with Section 87(1C) of the EPA Act 1992, as amended or Section 42(1C) of the Waste Management Act 1996, as amended. The application will be returned via the EDEN Portal, where they will have opportunity to re-submit once they have sourced any outstanding information.
