

Do I need a Waste Licence, Certificate of Registration, or a Registration Certificate ?

KEY
 COR – Certificate of Registration under SI 821 of 2007 as amended
 WEEE RC – Registration Certificate Under SI 340 of 2005
 Licence – Under Part V of the Waste Management Act
 P&D Act – Planning & Development Act 2000
 NB: See definitions in Article 5 of SI 821 of 2007

Local Authority activity exemptions from requirement to hold a Waste Licence or COR:

- WMA Section 39(7):- Specified waste activities on an IPPC regulated site; deposit of litter in a bin; the disposal of specified animal by-products; transfer of waste to an authorised person for Recovery.
- WMA Section 51:- Recovery of sludge for use in agriculture; recovery of animal or poultry blood or slurry/manure.
- Temporary storage (<6 months) of waste on the site of its production.
- Temp storage of waste portable batteries at workplaces. <250kg at any time. See Article 44 of SI 268 of 2008
