Bus from Eyre Square to Salthill – Route 401. Buses depart Eyre Square every 20 minutes going to Salthill. The timetable can be found here.

Walk: The conference venue is a 40-minute walk from the Galway train/bus station.

Cycle: Please ask for assistance at reception on arrival if cycling to the venue and a safe space will be provided to store your bicycle.

Drive: There are parking spaces available at the hotel for anyone driving, as well as 2 EV charging points in the underground carpark.

For those travelling to Galway by EV via the M6, there are <u>lonity</u> 350kw fast charging points near Athlone, N37 K066. The nearest ESB EV charger (max 50kw) to the Galway Bay Hotel is 3.7km away on the <u>Newcastle Road</u>.
